# Two ways to play in

## **LA READS 2021 Summer Sweepstakes**

All students can participate! Students can collect reading minutes by: (1) reading independently or (2) by actively participating in shared reading.

Here are some ways students can be active participants:

### Before reading

- Look through the book together. Look at the pictures and try to guess what will happen in the story.
- Ask questions that will elicit words and phrases that are used in the text.
- Introduce any unfamiliar vocabulary.
- Look at the cover of the book and talk about the author and illustrator.
- Encourage questions about the story so that you can look for the answer together while you read.

#### **During reading**

- · Model fluent and animated reading.
- Draw attention to how you read from top to bottom, left to right.
- Pause to:
  - Check your predictions.
  - Check comprehension.
  - Make connections to the story.
- Your child can do echo reading, choral reading, and fill in the gap reading.

#### After reading

- Have them close their eyes and imagine a part in the story and tell you the details they envision.
- Talk about how the story connects to the real world.
- Play with the words in the story.
  - Go on word hunts or letter hunts.
  - Look for words that rhyme
  - · Look for the number of syllables in a word
  - Look for the number of sounds in a word
  - Say a word like a robot and ask the students to blend the sounds to figure out the words.
