RE: Final Ministry Examinations

Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s),

As we are approaching the end of year, we want to remind you that there are mandatory Ministry Exams that occur in Cycle 3.2 (grade 6) elementary in the subject areas of English Language Arts and Mathematics. It is very important you be aware the impact these exam results can have for students' final grades on June report cards.

The Education Act states that in the subjects where there is a Ministry Exam, 20% of the student's final grade is to be based on the results of these final examinations. It is therefore critical that students write the final examination so as not to forfeit 20% of their grade. The only exception to this is serious and legitimate illness. If this happens, contact the principal, Sam Halpin (shalpin@wqsb.qc.ca), or the vice-principal, Hannah Patrick (hpatrick@wqsb.qc.ca).

At the elementary level there are no re-writes or summer school courses. As well, the elementary Cycle 3.2 exams are process exams that extend over several days. If a student is absent for a day, accommodations can likely be made. However, if a student is absent more than this, there is the possibility that they will forfeit 20% of their final grade. The following are the dates during which exams will be occurring:

English Language Arts: May 20th-June 6th, 2025.

Math: June 10th – June 12th, 2025
