Overview

Lord Aylmer School provides a dedicated homework/study space for Daycare students at the Senior Campus. The space aligns with Ministry of Education expectations and supports families wishing for their child to complete homework during daycare hours.

Homework/Study Space Details

- Location: Senior Campus
- Time: 3:30 p.m. - 4:00 p.m., daily
- Supervision: Daycare Educator
- Quiet, structured environment for homework and study

Roles & Responsibilities

Students:

- Attend independently
- Bring homework and required materials
- Use the time appropriately and respectfully

Daycare Educators:

- Supervise and ensure a calm environment
- Provide general support and maintain safety
- Not responsible for tracking homework, enforcing attendance, or tutoring

Clarifications

- The homework period does not replace remediation
- Parents remain responsible for ensuring homework completion

Ministry of Education Context

School-based childcare services aim to support student well-being, offer a climate conducive to development, and provide support for families where possible. Activities include routine activities, free play, short- and long-term workshops, special activities, and a homework period of about 30 minutes.
